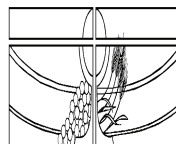

FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

118/60! That was the good news I received last week when I went to the Health and Wellness Fair. After 15 months as a pastor I still have decent blood pressure. I want to thank Maddie Hogan and all the healthcare providers for assisting, so professionally, all those who came to the auditorium throughout the day.

While last Sunday was "Respect Life Sunday" and was a good opportunity to evaluate, among other things, how we treat our bodies, today and next Sunday might be a way to check and take care of the health of the Church. Today is "Vocation Awareness Sunday" and next week is "World Mission Sunday." Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life as well as the Missionary - Evangelical outreach of the Church are two great vital signs as to how we are doing as the Body of Christ.

Even with the growth of lay ministries in the Church, the Priesthood and Consecrated Life have a special place now more than ever. Certainly with the Priesthood is the Celebration of the Eucharist which sadly is becoming less and less frequent as there are less and less Priests and more and more Catholics throughout the world. But also those in Consecrated life offer not only tireless service for the Gospel but also by their very lives and vows point our thoughts to the Kingdom of Heaven. Are we aware of the importance of such vocations? Do we try to foster vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life among our young people? The Missions wherever they are carried out are bringing the Gospel message and allowing others to experience the joy of Jesus and His Incarnation and Redemption.

Maybe this is the year you will join our parish Vocation Committee. Maybe this is the year you will add the intentions of the Missions right after your prayers for your children and grandchildren.

Almost a year to the day that I was formally installed as your pastor I'm content that one of my vital signs is good. Let's keep Vocations and the Missions in our thoughts and prayers so the Church will remain healthy in the future. God Bless.
