### FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

I have the chance to write you this Mission Sunday from the Holy Land. It's both beautiful and strange. Beautiful because of the numbers of the Christian faithful who like ourselves have traveled here and come with great devotion. Strange because in the Land of Jesus Christ, Christians are such a minority. In the last fifty years the Christian population has dropped dramatically especially in Lebanon but also in Israel and the Palestinian Authority.

On this Mission Sunday I am here where it all began and yet it is here where so many still need to come to know and love Jesus Christ. But not just here—everywhere! On every continent the Gospel Message needs to be preached, lived, shared. Some of that missionary work is done working along side of the peoples of a region and by fixing what needs to be attended to: simply put bettering lives. What St. Francis said so pointedly almost eight centuries ago still rings true today: "Preach the Gospel always, and at times, use words."

Faithful believers are in the minority in the Holy Land but also in our land, too. Not only are less and less people describing themselves as connected to a church community in the States, but also even fewer are attending weekly services. For us being Catholic is more than just being baptized once upon a time. We have to join in the Eucharistic Celebration of Mass each Sunday. It really is non-negotiable. As we distance ourselves from the Altar we distance ourselves from the Body of Christ and Christ the Head as well.

This Mission Sunday support the Missions generously. This Mission Sunday pray for the work of the Missions without a doubt. Moreover, this Mission Sunday join in the Mission work of the Church in your own homes and invite again those who have stopped celebrating the Resurrection with the Community of Believers to return again and take their rightful place around the Altar.
