FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

V. The Lord be with you. R. And also with you.

Over the past four decades that we have used the Mass of the Servant of God Paul VI since the Second Vatican Council, we have become so accustomed to this greeting in the English-speaking Church. Yet for those a little older they can well remember the original Latin from the Mass of St. Pius V: V. Dominus vobiscum. R. Et cum spiritu tuo. Few might even recall how "Et cum spiritu tuo" was translated as they followed the Mass for years in their personal Latin-English missal: "And with your spirit."

As the English-speaking Church prepares to introduce the Third Edition of the Roman Missal for the Mass of the Servant of God Paul VI one of the guiding principles is to have the English translation more authentically represent the original Latin text. For those of us who are familiar with the Mass in other languages we can see the difference in how "Et cum spiritu tuo" is translated: "And with your spirit." This Autumn, on the First Sunday of Advent, the English-speaking Church will begin using a new translation of the Mass we celebrate. While the structure is the same as we now use, many of the prayers of the priest and people will be altered in different ways so that the English Missal will more closely represent the original Latin text and other translations used throughout the Universal Church.

To help us here at Incarnation there will be an evening series this year about the Celebration of the Eucharist. The series: ***Welcoming the Roman Missal, Third Edition: My Prayer Book, The Prayer Book of the Church*** begins this Wednesday Evening at 7:30PM in our Lady's Conference Room. The first evening will focus on the Sunday Celebration of the Eucharist from the time of the Apostles to the present day and what, if any, prayer books were used.

The Mass is the most important thing we do as the Church. It is the summit to which every activity of the Church is directed and it is also the source from which all the Church's power flows. Because of its importance I invite you in a special way to join us for this important series about the Mass. I have already asked that the parish liturgical ministers be present as we begin to explore the upcoming changes in the English texts for priest and people alike. It's important for us because it's about our connection to our Lord as he commands us to "Do this in memory of me.

I hope to see you Wednesday Evening. God Bless!

Life Line Screening. We are pleased to offer a Life Line



Screening preventive health event that can be used to detect health risks. Life Line Screening uses a quantitative ultrasound bone densitometer, using the heel as a measurement site, to assess one's risk of osteoporosis. This screening compares your bone density to that of the average 20-year-old adult female, according to World Health Organization guidelines. The osteoporosis screening is not only for women.
