FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

As we gather for Mass on this Fourth Sunday of Lent, Laetare Sunday, the Church rejoices for Easter is so near. The rose vestments and cheerful music of the liturgy are a sure sign that this is not an ordinary Lenten Sunday. The scrutinies for our elect to be baptized at the Easter Vigil at the 10:30 Mass inspire us to think of new life, renewed by the Spirit. As we gather for Mass this weekend our diocese is in a process of reflection and renewal. Each parish is asked to have a self-study and submit the results and accompanying parish response to the diocese to determine its viability and vitality.

On this Sunday of Lenten Joy we have plenty to be thankful and happy about here at Incarnation. Close to 1,500 people come to worship here each weekend. Not just on Sundays but people are being nourished day after day; morning, noon and night. There are opportunities to learn more about our faith, to pray together in small groups. We have opportunities to gather socially and support each other on our journey to the Promised Land.

Our vitality is seen in the quality and strength of Incarnation School which is registering students for the upcoming school year. Wonderful students guided by a dedicated faculty and parents who understand the benefits of a Catholic Education despite the sacrifices that they must make. Currently 315 students are welcomed to our doors each morning—one of the larger schools in the diocese. As we mark the midpoint of Lent, our parish looks toward the Celebrations surrounding our Parish Feast Day. On the Annunciation of the Lord we recall when by the power of the Holy Spirit, the Word became Flesh in the womb of the Virgin. Hopefully you will come out for 7:30PM Mass on Thursday, March 25th as we joyfully recall the beginning of our Salvation. But our celebrations are also focused on us—we have seen God's Glory and that effects who we are and how we see each other. On Saturday, March 27th we will have a Gala Dinner Dance Celebration. Tickets are only \$35. for a packed evening of fun, good food and drink, dancing, prizes, surprises, smiles and so much more. I know this will be a great experience for all the adults of the Incarnation.

In our eighth decade Incarnation has all the hallmarks of being viable and vital. Next week we hope to give more information for you to read in the bulletin. Rejoice! And God Bless!

 - *Apply NOW! Remember, it's first come — first serve basis. Don't miss out on a quality education.
 - *Scholarship ranges from \$1,600 to \$2,500. Just think of only paying a monthly tuition of \$100!
- Documents needed: Report Card and 2009 Federal 1040 tax form. **If you did not file, you can have a notarized statement to this effect.**
