Happy Easter Everyone!

How warming those words must have been to the disciples who had witnessed the horrors of the crucifixion. But Jesus did not only appear to the women at the tomb or the two on the road to Emmaus or to even Simon Peter himself. The gospels account that he appears to followers in the hundreds after the Resurrection. No wonder the infant Church was so strong in her faith even to the point of shedding blood rather than to deny the Resurrection of Jesus.

Jesus has also appeared to me! In the nine months that I have been at Incarnation I have seen him at the Altar. I met him last summer when so many of you came to the rectory to speak with me. I have seen his eyes in the sparkling eyes of our youngsters as they come to Incarnation each morning Sunday through Friday to learn about God's goodness. I have seen his handiwork as gifts or grocery bags were brought to church by the hundreds in Advent or on Palm Sunday.

I have encountered Christ Risen in his diverse Body here at Incarnation with so many gifts and willingness to assist others. A vibrant and living Christ has appeared to me as we have gathered for prayer in small groups or at packed Masses; as we have danced penance or danced and partied together. He has approached me at wakes and funerals as people have dealt with painful circumstances with bedrock faith.

The Risen Lord has appeared to me in the faces and fervor of those newly initiated at the Great Easter Vigil as they have given of themselves this past year so as to join his living body, the Church. I have seen him in the excited children who received the sacrament of Penance last month or the all-too-cool teenagers who were filled with the Holy Spirit at their Confirmation last November.

My Good People of Incarnation, the Lord has appeared to me! Through you these past nine months I have seen the Risen Lord. Thank you so much.

As we begin this glorious Easter Season may we continue to work tirelessly so that more and more people may have Christ appear to them.
