What a treat! What a wonderful way to celebrate a birthday. Almost 200 people came out Wednesday night, September 8th for our Marian Evening, celebrating the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It was a moving tribute to someone who is loved dearly. It was all too apparent how her children want to be close to their mother and how firmly we believe that she is close to us on our life's journey.

Another opportunity to show our love for the mother of God is to join in the Diocesan Pilgrimage to the National Shrine in Washington, DC at the end of October. Our diocese has consistently had the largest pilgrimages to the shrine through the years of its existence. This year Incarnation is participating in the overnight option so that we can spend more time sightseeing in the nation's capitol as well as be well rested for the visit to the shrine as well. The trip includes deluxe coach travel, a four hour guided tour of Washington, DC., visit to the Pope John Paul II Cultural Center or the Franciscan Holy Land of America Shrine (still to be decided), dinner, accommodations and breakfast at the Arlington Hilton, and of course, the Diocesan Mass at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. The whole trip costs only \$249.00 per person (double occupancy) and it is cheaper if pilgrims want to lodge three or four to a suite.

Now that we are back from summer vacations and travels it's important that the remainder of the registrations come to the rectory. Registration deadline is September 30th. A Registration slip may be found on page five of this bulletin. After that date we cannot guarantee a space or the great fares being offered. It will be a memorable trip to see Washington in the beauty of autumn and to conclude the month of the Holy Rosary at Mary's Shrine.

I hope you will be able to join the Incarnation family and thousands of pilgrims from the Diocese of Brooklyn and Queens as we go to honor Mary Immaculate: Patroness of our Diocese and patroness of our Nation.
