## FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN GENERATIONS OF FAITH

As I spoke about at all the Masses back in Lent, Incarnation is one of the “Pilot Parishes” for the *Generations of Faith* Capital Campaign. The campaign will take place in all the parishes of the diocese. Incarnation and twenty or so other parishes are going first. Why us? Why first? I think Incarnation was chosen because it is a mid-sized parish that is culturally diverse as is our diocese. I asked that we be considered for the pilot phase because I thought the timing would be beneficial. It nicely replaces the Annual Catholic Appeal which we at Incarnation will not take part in this year. It also helps that the soon we start the campaign, the sooner the parish can reap the benefits of your sacrificial generosity.

The monies raised at Incarnation will benefit the senior priests who served us through the years. It will also allow for a youth ministry initiative that will help our young people. There are also three concrete projects we need to undertake for the better safety, upkeep and comfort of all at Incarnation. Those three projects are: the replacement of the convent roof and fixing water damage on the upper floors; the security enhancements for the church, and adjusting the church windows so that they allow for better ventilation in the spring and autumn.

Of course the more individuals and families who make a pledge the better we will do in the five year undertaking. Moreover, I hope that it will be an opportunity for shared sacrifice. That shared sacrifice is how Incarnation has done so well for so many years. A six thousand (6,000) dollar pledge over the five years is less than twenty-five (25) dollars a week. Sure that is a sacrifice. But it is the equivalent of a Starbuck's coffee each day. We will be reaching out to the entire parish during the first two weekends of May.

As this *Generations of Faith Campaign* moves to its completion here at I ask that you pray for its success and reflect on the heroic sacrificial offering that you will make so we can pass our parish over to future generations as it has been passed down to us for almost ninety years.

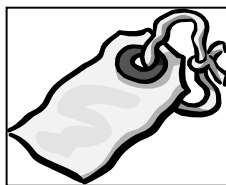


**ALTAR SERVER INSTALLATION** will take place at the 5PM Mass on Saturday, April 25. All are invited.
