FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Here is the translation to another beautiful Latin Easter hymn, Ad Coenam Agni composed not much after the year 500 or so:

1. *THE Lamb's high banquet we await
in snow-white robes of royal state:
and now, the Red Sea's channel past,
to Christ our Prince we sing at last.*

3. *That Paschal Eve God's arm was bared,
the devastating Angel spared:
by strength of hand our hosts went free
from Pharaoh's ruthless tyranny.*

5. *O Thou, from whom hell's monarch flies,
O great, O very Sacrifice,
Thy captive people are set free,
and endless life restored in Thee.*

7. *We pray Thee, King with glory decked,
in this our Paschal joy, protect
from all that death would fain effect
Thy ransomed flock, Thine own elect.*

2. *Upon the Altar of the Cross
His Body hath redeemed our loss:
and tasting of his roseate Blood,
our life is hid with Him in God.*

4. *Now Christ, our Paschal Lamb, is slain,
the Lamb of God that knows no stain,
the true Oblation offered here,
our own unleavened Bread sincere.*

6. *For Christ, arising from the dead,
from conquered hell victorious sped,
and thrust the tyrant down to chains,
and Paradise for us regains.*

8. *To Thee who, dead, again does live,
all glory Lord, Thy people give;
all glory, as is ever meet,
to Father and to Paraclete. Amen.*

Wishing everyone a Blessed Easter! May the Power and the Peace of the Risen One Prevail in Our Hearts and in Our World.

Securing an Annual *Living Light* Votive Candle to Honor a Loved One, Remember a Special Intention, or Mark a Milestone is a continual and wonderful way to celebrate sentiments and offer intercessions of remembrance, hope and gratitude. Two wall mounted electric candle stands now hang in our church on either side of the newly restored and expanded Saints' Shrine. These unique and inviting candles are made of real wax with electrified illumination to insure your *Living Light* burns brightly throughout the year. A plaque displaying the name of your loved one, your intention, or your milestone will be mounted before your *Living Light* Votive Candle. Plaques will remain for the year you have secured your *Living Light* and may be renewed or rededicated for additional 12 month periods. In addition to its rightful place before your *Living Light* in the Saints' Shrine, your Loved One, Special Intention, or Milestone will also be included in the *Living Light* Section of the Parish Website. Please do not seal the envelope with staples, tape or stickers. Do not staple envelopes together. If no envelope contributions are made for a year, that person will be dropped from the envelope mailing list. *Please notify the Rectory if you are moving, so that we can remove your name from the mailing list.*
