Last week I posted a little bit about Father Chris. He joined us for our staff planning day and has celebrated the morning Mass a few times since his ordination. I must admit I am excited about his ministry in our midst. He will start settling in tomorrow. Slowly he will learn about our community and we will learn about him. I don't really know him that well yet myself.

What I do know about is you. With Father Chris' assignment here I have been hearing a lot about Incarnation from his family and friends. Some of which might have come from first hand experience, perhaps visitors to Incarnation, more of which I suspect has come from the priests who have ministered here through the years.
