FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

AC: 101 (Reprinted from July 2012)

Believe it or not I get more comments, letters, messages or emails about air conditioning than anything else: “It’s too hot, It’s too cold, It’s too noisy, It’s too breezy.” I guess I should take some solace in the fact that no one has complained about my preaching or trying to implement our Parish Goals. Nevertheless as we conclude our third “official” heat wave of the summer I thought I would offer a short Incarnation Air Conditioning Primer.

Unfortunately, our church is not blessed with large windows. I’ve been on ships with bigger portals. The lack of cross ventilation forces us to put the AC on for some Masses beginning as early as April and often into the end of October. While not blessed with large windows, Incarnation has been blessed with AC for a long time. While not quite as old as myself—I just turned 45—our AC is not too far behind. In reality it is an old system.

The system has four (4) units. There are two (2) smaller and much quieter units by the sanctuary, and two (2) larger and noisier units by the choir loft. Whenever the windows are closed one (1) or all of the units are operational. **You might not hear the quieter units as you do the larger ones but they are on.** Please do not open windows. The two (2) larger units by the choir loft do most of the work and give me most of the complaints. Yes, they are noisy and breezy which can be uncomfortable. But they also do most of the cooling.

A question that often arises is “What temperature is the AC set at?” Well, our AC is just an “On/Off” system. But with that being said, the temperature the staff has asked to keep the church at is 73 degrees. They monitor the thermostat that is in the sacristy to try to maintain 73 degrees. I realize some days that it is the humidity more than the heat that is uncomfortable and so the AC is operational on those days as well. If needed one could always bring a light sweater to Mass, or sit along the windows or in the rear of church where the breeze from the blowers is not as strong.

When possible the staff tries to use the larger/noisier/breezier units before or between Masses to cool the church and then use the smaller/quieter units during the Mass to maintain the temperature. Try not to leave doors open as we loose the cool. It’s not the best AC system. But it’s ours. Please be as generous as possible as we are having our Summer Air Conditioning Collection. There are white envelopes by all the doors of the church.
