FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Thursday, June 23rd, started very promising. There was excitement in the air as the Chaplain to Creedmoor was moving into the rectory that morning and it was the last day of the 2010-2011 Academic Year at Incarnation School. As the fog began to burn off, however, things took a turn for the worse. The New York City Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) notified the parish that there was a water main severely leaking within the convent walls. It was detected from their offices (however that can happen). Additionally the parish was served with a notice that if the repairs did not begin by June 30th the DEP would stop water service to the Sisters in the convent.

As far as repairs around Incarnation go, it's not the biggest job. We just had work completed at the beginning of June on the school (pointing, flashing and installation of window gates) and on the slate roofs of the church and St. Joseph's House (patch work) all totaling \$79,650.00.

The problem is the roof work was foreseen and planned into the parish budget. This latest surprise will total close to \$10,000.00 once all complete. Because the repair falls so late in the fiscal year there are not funds to cover it.

The notice of water termination did not allow us the luxury to defer maintenance. Yes, even Sisters need water! The work was begun and completed but the bill remains.

I am asking everyone to help cover the cost of the Convent Water Main repairs. The second collection for this week and next will be devoted to this unforeseen but very necessary project. Please mark your offering "Convent." On behalf of the Sisters of Incarnation, Thank you.

CHURCH ETIQUETTE. Have a seat! We ask everyone to take their rightful place in the assembly using the pews at Mass. With the exception of a handful of celebrations each year there are seats for everyone. Standing along the walls in the back of the church is causing damage to the walls and prohibits those who might want to stop in church to say a little prayer by the shrines. It can block the entrance way and doesn't allow people the use of the hymnals which are needed for the hymns and psalm at Mass. Lastly, standing by the doors could give the impression that you are not fully engaged in the Celebration of the Eucharist: half in, half out, so to speak. So come in and have a seat and pray a while!
