FROM THE PASTOR’S PEN

“Are we there yet?” The burst of warm weather has turned my thoughts to summer and summer vacations. And the all too familiar question from the kids: “Are we there yet?” But with Easter so late this year, I’m the big kid crying out about Pentecost: “Are we there yet?” It’s almost crazy to think of Pentecost in June. And yet this year it is.

The challenge for us is to change the cry of “Are we there yet?” to “Come, Holy Spirit!” Yearnings for the celebration of Pentecost should be yearnings for the Gifts of the Holy Spirit and the unity that the Holy Spirit brings to all who welcome Him into their lives.

To help celebrate the Coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost some suggestions

- If you are free in the morning join in the Holy Spirit Novena after the 8:30 Mass this week
- Celebrate at the 5PM Multi-Cultural Pentecost Vigil on Saturday, June 7. Pentecost is the feast of our unity and diversity as the Family of the Church
- Prepare a favorite family or ethnic dish to share at the Pot Luck Pentecost Supper. Just drop the dish off in the auditorium before the 5PM Mass on Saturday, June 7
- Say a special prayer for those adults who are being Confirmed at the Pentecost Vigil. Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen them in their faith
- Take a moment or two to reflect on the gifts and power of the Spirit in your own life
- Simply wear something Red to Mass next weekend to celebrate the Spirit

Each Sunday we profess that the Holy Spirit is the “Lord, the giver of life.” The Spirit is the life giving breath of the Church; the presence of God within you and me. Open your minds and hearts to the mystery of the Holy Spirit in your life.

“So are we there yet? You bet!” Come, Holy Spirit!
