FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

As we celebrate the Body and Blood of Christ with renewed devotion this weekend, it's hard to separate the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist from the Sacrament of Holy Orders. For whatever the reason in the Divine Plan the former flows from the latter. For this reason it is always important to have prayers for priestly vocations in our hearts and actions nurturing priestly vocations in our daily routines.

While the time has gone quickly, I think that our seminarian, Melchezedek, has benefitted being in Hollis and Queens Village this Spring. I know his enthusiasm has made an impression on many here at Incarnation. Next week he is off to Spanish studies in Costa Rica before returning to the seminary in August. The plan is that he will return to us next spring. Please keep him in your prayers.

Corpus Christi Sunday nearly brings Father Kuroly's ministry at Incarnation to a close. Beginning July 1 the Bishop has given him another assignment in Brooklyn. For me he has been not only a help these past years but a joy to see each weekend. While his assignment here was to work with our Spanish community he has done much more. He has become a staple of the Incarnation Family and I would never have attempted my sabbatical last year without his presence here.

Next Sunday, Father Kuroly will celebrate the 12noon Spanish Mass. There will be a special presentation to thank him at that Mass. We wanted to have an additional gathering but Father Kuroly thought the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist together more appropriate. I know he will remember us in prayer and I assured him we will do the same for him.

A consolation for our diocese is that the Bishop will ordain thirteen men to the priesthood this Saturday. One of the largest classes in my memory. May God's blessings shower upon these men whose ministry is centered on, and derives its fruitfulness through, the Body and Blood of Christ.
