**FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN**

“It’s the Real Deal!” That phrase keeps popping into my head as we gather for Mass this weekend on the Feast of Corpus Christi-The Body and Blood of Jesus. Sadly fewer and fewer Catholics agree with the words of Jesus and the constant teaching of the Church. Some outright disagree others are shaky in their faith that Jesus Christ, God’s Only Son is really present in the Holy Eucharist, Holy Communion.

It’s evident when people miss Mass on Sundays because they “had some thing they just had to do.” What could literally bump time with Jesus Christ? And yet that is what happens when people and things keep us from Sunday Mass. Sometimes at Mass we get distracted—it’s human. I have had the opportunity to be in the presence of popes and presidents, nobility and noteworthy athletes. I can assure you I rarely took my eyes off of them. Do I always give that same attention to the Sacred Body and Blood of Jesus at Mass? Unfortunately I can’t give an unequivocal “yes.” But I can redouble my efforts to enjoy and appreciate the gift of God’s Presence in my midst.

Not only is the reality of Jesus accessible when we are properly prepared and disposed to receive Holy Communion, but we also have the chance to experience His Real Presence when we come into the quiet of a Catholic church. Incarnation is open each weekday until 5PM and a little later on Saturday and Sunday. I have always found it remarkable how much God says to me—the direction He points me in—when I give Him the chance.

While many may claim that this or that is the “real deal,” let us never forget what Jesus Himself said and what we hear in today’s gospel: “My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink.” He sounds pretty clear that the Eucharist we receive at Mass is the “Real Deal!” Be with Him each Sunday if not each day in the days, months and years to come.

It can block the entrance way and doesn't allow people the use of the hymnals which are needed for the hymns and psalm at Mass. Lastly, standing by the doors could give the impression that you are not fully engaged in the Celebration of the Eucharist: half in, half out, so to speak. So come in and have a seat and pray a while!
