FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Saturday at the conclusion of the Ordination Mass Bishop DiMarzio assigned a **newly ordained priest** to Incarnation. A First Assignment is always a special time in the life of a priest and I hope that we will be welcoming as he begins his new ministry among us. I hope that it will be a time rich in God's Blessings.

Those blessings are apparent in Sr. Joan's ministry at Incarnation. She now begins a long due summer vacation that will bring her to her new parish of St. Christopher's in Baldwin. I am happy to announce that **Marie Fouche and Olga Petito** will take on the role of Religious Education Coordinators at the parish. They have both received Pastoral Ministry diplomas, Marie from the Diocese of Brooklyn and Olga from the Diocese of Rockville Centre. They will manage our Faith Formation Program with the assistance of our new associate pastor. Besides their experience in childhood and adult Faith Formation, they also have fluency in English, French, Kreyol and Spanish. I am excited about the assistance and perspective they will bring to the parish pastoral staff.

The last of our new additions comes in the person of **Rose Ruesing**. Incarnation was selected to receive a Youth Ministry Initiative grant from The Catholic Foundation of Brooklyn and Queens. The grant allows us to hire a part time Youth Ministry Professional to assist and support our volunteers who work with our young people. Rose already ministers at St. Nicholas and Immaculate Conception parishes within our local deanery and I know that she will share her expertise with the young people here and those who assist them.

While summer is usually a sleepy time in the life of a parish I expect that Incarnation will be humming with these new additions. In fact I become new too, this week as I begin my second term as pastor of Incarnation. The time has sped by. I attribute that to the great time I am having. I've told you many times before I loving being the pastor of Incarnation. Your devotion; your faithfulness; your generosity and enthusiasm for what goes on here has made all the difference in the world.

This Wednesday the parish staff will go away for the day to plan for the next pastoral year beginning in September. It's important for us. It's important for you. Please keep us in your prayers.

Lastly, remember that while I mentioned a lot of staff names above, the staff will always come and go while the parish is all about you and your loved ones!

NEW PRIEST FOR INCARNATION. At the conclusion of Saturday's Ordination Ceremony, Bishop DiMarzio has assigned a newly ordained priest to assist Father O'Connor as a Parochial Vicar here at Incarnation. The new priest will take up residence here and begin his ministry among us on July 13.

FORTNIGHT FOR FREEDOM. The fourteen days from June 21—the vigil of the Feasts of St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More—to July 4, Independence Day, are dedicated to this “fortnight for freedom”—a great hymn of



prayer for our country. Our liturgical calendar celebrates a series of great martyrs who remained faithful in the face of persecution by political power—St. John Fisher and St. Thomas More, St. John the Baptist, SS. Peter and Paul, and the First Martyrs of the Church of Rome. Culminating on Independence Day, this special period of prayer, study, catechesis, and public action will emphasize both our Christian and American heritage of liberty.
