## FROM THE PASTOR'S PENPAL

“The EUCHARIST is the source and summit of the Christian Life.”

It is an action of thanksgiving according to the Greek words ‘Eucharistein’ or ‘Eulogein’. It recalls the Jewish blessings that proclaim God’s Works: Creation, Redemption and Sanctification. (Catechism of the Catholic Church).

This Great Sacrament has so many names: Eucharistic Assembly, Memorial of the Lord’s Passion, Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, Sacrifice of Praise, Spiritual Sacrifice Holy and Divine Mystery, Most Blessed Sacrament, Holy Communion, Bread of Angels, Bread from Heaven, Holy Mass... The Bread and Wine offered by the King Priest Melchizedek is a prefiguration of this sacrament.

With Jesus the Bread and Wine become the Body and Blood of the Savior. He asks us to eat that Body and drink this Blood to have his life, and to repeat it until he comes again. Think, He has offered all to his heavenly Father, keeping nothing back. He did it out of love for our Humanity of which he was a member. Personally he had nothing to redeem, ‘sinless in the sinner’s stead’. He gave back all to that Father out of love and obedience so that his will would be always and completely the will of that Father.

Yes, He is present in the Eucharist offering himself in a non-bloody sacrifice to feed us, to live in us, bringing comfort, strength, love, faith, healing, and hope, granting eternal life to those who believe in him.

Lord Jesus, make that our will be totally conformed to yours; when we fail may your infinite merits be our safe guard and may the Holy Spirit fill us with contrition, love, forgiveness and strength. Through your Body and Blood let us remain inseparably united to You.

**SUMMER OFFICE HOURS BEGIN THIS**

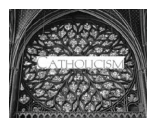
