FROM THE PASTOR’S PEN

As we gather on this Corpus Christi Sunday we have the opportunity to give thanks to God for all His blessings, especially His Gift of the Holy Eucharist that sustains us throughout our lives and brings us into greater Communion with Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Sadly it is often a Gift that is overlooked or not fully appreciated. I hope that you will make an effort today to spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament or even come for 4PM Vespers and Benediction on this great feast of His Body and Blood.

Included as an insert in this weekend’s bulletin is a reminder about how to properly receive Holy Communion. It should be a highlight of our day or of our week, this Sacramental encounter with the Risen Jesus. Sometimes though we can get into bad habits or fail to realize what exactly is happening when we approach the Altar to receive His Sacred Body and Precious Blood. I hope you take some time to look it over and maybe even discuss it as a family.

Related to the Holy Eucharist, I am happy to relate to you that Msgr. Arella will be returning to the Mass rotation beginning next week. After his back surgery and successful rehab he is finally able to return to celebrate Holy Mass for you next weekend. How long he stays depends not only on his health but also on the possibility that the Bishop might assign a newly ordained priest to Incarnation at the end of the month. As you know for the last year I have been holding down three jobs as Pastor, Director of the Diocesan Liturgy Office and local Dean. I could sure use the help and it would be exciting for the whole community if we had a newly ordained priest assigned here. Say a prayer we get a good and holy priest!

Have you been having a hard time getting to church? We are working on that. The passage between the school and convent leading to and from Francis Lewis Blvd has been closed as work begins to replace the convent roof. I was told that the project will be completed by July but I am hoping that it will be finished before that. It has taken a while but I just signed the contract for the new chair lift to be installed in the main church vestibule. There was much red tape and I learned much more than I should know about ordinances and regulations. Nevertheless, it should be in and running by next Sunday.

Lastly, there is the blood drive today from 8:30AM-2PM in the school auditorium. I hope you will stop over and give about an hour of your time and a pint of your blood. Fittingly it’s the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus which makes me recall what I heard as a kid: Christ’s Blood is Precious and so is yours to one in need!
