As we have our eyes fixed to the sky, we open wide our arms and our hearts to say with great expectation: “Come Lord Jesus! Send us your Spirit to dwell in our hearts” to “enkindle” in them the “fire of your love.” We firmly believe that by dwelling in us, you will prepare us to receive the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit which is the Most Holy Trinity.

Therefore the Holy Spirit will come to us as Consoler of the abandoned souls, Protector of the needy and the Help of the afflicted. It will help us to strengthen the weak and to give courage to the hopeless. As St. Augustine said, we will call on the Holy Spirit to come and purify us so that no evil desire can take possession of us.
