It might as well snow, I've already seen Christmas lights up, and you know if you've been in a store recently it's pretty much all Christmas all the time. But hold on! Between now and December 24th there is still much to do here at Incarnation.

Thursday Bishop Caggiano will visit Incarnation to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to forty of our young men and women. They have been diligently preparing and perhaps you are still praying for a candidate by name! And next Sunday ten new ministers will be commissioned at the 10:30 Mass to assist in proclaiming the Scriptures and distributing the Sacred Body and Blood of the Lord at Mass. Thank goodness there will be a little bit of time to rest and watch a movie as the Family Life Committee is sponsoring Family Movie night this Saturday. Movie and a meal for only \$5. just can't be beat.

This Advent will have an added specialness as the new universal English translation of the Mass will come into force. We have been preparing since February and it is almost here. We have begun introducing the sung Mass parts and next Sunday the bulletin will have an insert with the new responses so you can take them home and look over them. Beginning the first weekend of Advent there will be pew cards with the new responses to assist in your worship whenever you come to Mass. On Wednesday, November 16, there will be an opportunity to go over the translation for all the People's Parts as we have the last evening of the Roman Missal Series: "***A New Translation: A Deeper Meaning, the Same Mass.***" It will be in Our Lady's Meeting Room at 7:30PM. I hope you will try to join us on the 16th.

Before Advent begins a new Liturgical Year, the present Church year comes to a close with the Great feast of Christ the King. On that Sunday we will witness as the Confirmation Candidates of 2012 will make their public commitment to serious preparation for the Sacrament. I hope that you will pray for these young people as they strive to be ready for the coming of the Holy Spirit in a special way at Confirmation next year.

The Solemnity of Christ the King will also give the rare opportunity for Eucharistic Adoration on a Sunday. The Blessed Sacrament will remain on the Altar following the 12noon Mass giving everyone the opportunity to worship the Lamb who was slain for us. The afternoon will conclude with Solemn Evening Prayer and Benediction at 4:15PM. What a wonderful way to spend some of Sunday with your family: children or grandchildren. In fact what a wonderful way to close out the Liturgical Year in preparation for the craziness of the Holiday Season.

Priest: The Lord be with you.

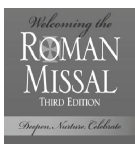
People: **And with your spirit.**
