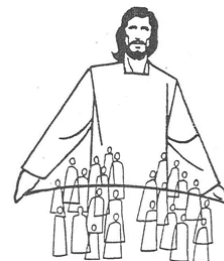

FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

June 18, 1927.

If you Google that date you wont find much. The US government issued an air mail stamp that day: 10 cents just imagine. But, it is a rather important day for us here at the parish. On Saturday, June 18, 1927 Incarnation as a parish came into existence and was recognized by the State of New York. There was nothing here of course. Father John Dockery had been assigned earlier that year in April to come out and start saying a Sunday Mass at the Bellaire Theatre on Jamaica Avenue for the Catholics in the area. Our country church would not see the first Mass celebrated until Christmas 1928 and Archbishop Molloy would not make it out this way until December 22, 1929 to dedicate the church. But as far as officially our parish birthday is June 18, 1927. Believe it or not we are pushing 90!

I will be gathering a group to help us celebrate such a great milestone. I hope you will consider joining in the fun and festivities. I envision our celebrations beginning this Spring as the parish celebrates the Solemnity of the Annunciation when the Jesus became Incarnate in the womb of His Blessed Mother. The celebrations will continue until June of 2017 when the Bishop will be invited to celebrate a Thanksgiving Mass.

What happens in between those two events will be up to you. We have a vibrant and rich community here at Incarnation with a many cultures and even more creativity. I hope this celebration as we near 90 will be a time of grace and enthusiasm for the Gospel. I've been to many spectacular parish anniversary celebrations and I hope our will not just rival those but also bring us closer together as the followers of Jesus rich in our diversity but cemented together in our Faith.

These celebrations, however, should be more than just show. They are opportunities to renew our faith here and to reach out to others who either share are faith and are challenged by the community of the Church or who have yet to have been introduced to Jesus and His Church. This is why we were founded back in 1927. This is why we look to 2017 and beyond!

You'll hear more about this without a doubt. I just wanted to get your creative juices going as we look to our 90th Anniversary celebrations together.
