# “BRING A FRIEND TO CHURCH!”

## FROM THE PASTOR’S PEN

This weekend the Church observes Vocation Awareness Sunday. One part of this weekend’s focus is on the importance of vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life in our lives as Catholic-Christians. Another part of the focus is to nurture those boys and girls, men and women who might have, or be actively discerning, a Church vocation. We are very fortunate that Father Kevin Abels, our Diocesan Vocation Director, will be here this weekend to speak to the students of the Religious Education Program and celebrate the 10:30 Mass.

At the end of the Mass Father Abels will give out the Good Shepherd Statue to the first of our parishioners who will bring it home for a week of intense prayer, asking God to enrich the Church with more good and holy priests. Along with the statue is a folder that has prayers, information and even games for people of all ages to assist not only in common prayers together but also in discussions about Church vocations.

In the weeks after Father Abels leaves the parish we will share in the “Called by Name” experience. The title “Called by Name” comes from Isaiah 43:1 “I have called you by name, you are mine.” Such is the relation of God and His people; such is the relationship between Jesus Christ and those He calls to serve Him in His Mystical Body the Church. The call of a vocation is always an intimate invitation from God to a specific individual who as gifts and difficulties that are common to the whole human family.

But who are these women and men called by name? Look around and you will see their faces. They are in our midst. They live in our homes and worship in our church. We can find them in our school during the week or on Sundays. They already serve us in various ministries in the Church or perhaps they remember us anonymously in their prayers at bedtime. We know who they are as we call them son or sister, grandson or aunt.

Sometimes, though, they need our help. Because of the many distractions of our world and culture they may be unaware that they are being called by name. They might even feel alone or fearful that their affirmative response to God might be seen as a slight of friends and family. This is why I will ask your help as we try as a parish and community to surface those who are called so that we can assist and support them as they discern God’s voice and seek to do His will for themselves and their Church.
