Whether or not you like Louie Armstrong or New Orleans, I'm sure its hard to keep toes from tapping when you hear that refrain. And yet, I don't think it's only the beat that draws us in. I think it's also our desire to be close to the saints. We want “to be in that number” and be among the saints. Their place as examples and intercessors should remind and inspire us as we, too, are members of the communion of saints.

The Christian Faithful throughout history have used the arts to strengthen that bond between the Saints in heaven and God's Holy Ones on earth. Icons, statues, mosaics and stain glass, as well as modern day pictures, remind us of the closeness of the saints. At Incarnation the two shrines of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Sacred Heart in the back of the church have fostered the faith of thousands through the years.

Later this autumn additional saints' statues will be added to the Sacred Heart Shrine in church. Sixteen inch statues will be placed behind the new red candle stand in the Sacred Heart Shrine. It is my hope that the new statues will be in place for the Solemnity of All Saints but they are being hand carved in Italy so it might take longer.

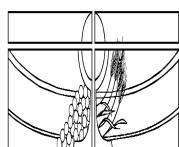

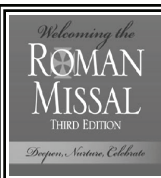

THIRD EDITION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL.

V. The Lord be with you. R. And with your spirit. One of the first changes you will notice in the new Mass translation is the people's response to *The Lord be with you*. The use of the word "spirit" connects the greeting to its biblical roots — it's used in the Old Testament and at the end of several of St. Paul's Letters; its historical usage — it was in widespread use by the fourth century; and the spiritual nature of the events to take place — it is not a greeting that is used on the street. Other languages also use their equivalent of the word: "spirit."
