PASTOR'S MESSAGE (BILINGUAL)

Welcome to 2021! Thank God!

As we enter this year we are still in a pandemic, but there is hope and light at the end of this road.

While we still need to be careful, we are safe in church, I invite everyone to talk to neighbors, friends, and loved ones and talk about two important items for 2021

Discern when it is time to come back to Sunday mass and enter church. We will still be using masks, social distance, hand sanitizer, and cleaning the church hard and often. But we are safe here. Never be afraid to come to church and while, thanks to wifi and live streaming, we can pray in our homes, it is not the same, and it is a different grace, to come to church on Sunday and receive Jesus in the Eucharist! Now as we start 2021 it is time to be challenged, and ask the difficult questions and start the process to come back to church.

It is time to talk to your doctor and prepare to take the “shot”. Do not be afraid. The Bishops have reviewed the “shot” for its moral value and have said its ok to take it. Please talk to your doctor and with your doctors help, discern when to take it. I, the deacons, and the priests will take it when it comes to our turn. (one of the priests who I live with already has taken it, he is a hospital chaplain). We take it for our own health, but also to protect our family, our parish, and our society. It is an act of charity and obedience to talk to your doctor and take it if you are able.

As we enter into 2021 and leave 2020 behind, let us double our efforts to be witnesses of the power of the Sacraments and the church and ask for the grace of God upon us all.

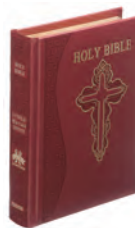
