# ***PASTOR'S MESSAGE (BILINGUAL)***

*As was announced in the bulletin and in the Tablet, Fr Ray will be leaving the diocese soon to return to his ministry as a Carmelite priest in India. I wanted to share with you some of the origins of his order so you can pray for and with him:*

The Carmelites are a religious group within the Catholic Church. Their name derives from Mt. Carmel, the place of their outset in the Holy Land I myself have visited this sight a number of times on pilgrimages abs on retreat

Toward the end of the 12th century, during the crusades, a small group of Latin hermits settled on the slopes of Mt. Carmel, wishing to imitate Prophet Elijah through a solitary way of life.

Following the Prophet's experience and with the same passion which led him to exclaim: "Burning with zeal for the Lord of Hosts". the hermits embraced a life of silence and solitude, abiding the grottos of the mountain and meditating the Word of God.

Sometime between 1206 and 1214, the Prior – of whom only the initial of the first name is known – asked Albert, the then Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem, to approve a rule of life for the hermits.

This way, they obtained an official recognition as a community within the local Church, a prelude to their recognition as a religious order, which took place only years later, by the Pope. A few years later, around 1226, they built a small church near their grottos, dedicated to Our Lady whom the hermits considered as a mother, patroness and model of life and of prayer.

Dominicans in Africa are currently located in some 25 countries. Our Dominican Province of Nigeria & Ghana is the largest entity on the African continent. We are engaged in a diversity of ministries. Our efforts are very much concentrated in the areas of basic formation and training for the priesthood and religious life; primary evangelization in rural parts of Africa; on-going Christian formation in the faith through parish ministries; ministry among Muslims; social justice ministries, and health care delivery; chaplaincies and education ministries at all levels. We are committed to bringing Christ in a relevant way to all the people that we minister unto. In his presentation, our representative will be making references to these ministerial engagements of ours. We would greatly appreciate your support and encouragement for a successful appeal.

# ***PASTOR'S MESSAGE (BILINGUAL)***

## ***Mensaje de Parroco***

Como se anunció en el boletín y en el Tablet, el Padre Ray dejará pronto la diócesis para volver a su ministerio como sacerdote carmelita en la India. Quiero compartir con ustedes algunos de los orígenes de su orden para que puedan rezar por y con él.

Los Carmelitas es un grupo religioso dentro de la Iglesia Católica. Su nombre deriva del Monte Carmelo, el lugar de su origen en Tierra Santa. Yo mismo he visitado este lugar varias veces en peregrinación y en retiro.

A finales del siglo XII, durante las cruzadas, un pequeño grupo de ermitaños latinos se instaló en las laderas del monte Carmelo, con el deseo de imitar al profeta Elías mediante una forma de vida solitaria.

Siguiendo la experiencia del Profeta y con la misma pasión que le llevó a exclamar: "Ardiendo de celo por el Señor de los Ejércitos", los ermitaños abrazaron una vida de silencio y soledad, habitando las grutas del monte y meditando la Palabra de Dios.

Alrededor de 1240 se fundaron los primeros conventos en Europa. Incluso el rey Luis IX de Francia, al regresar de una cruzada en 1254, trajo consigo a algunos carmelitas a Europa, promoviendo así su expansión. En el año 1291, con el asedio y la conquista de San Juan de Acre por los mamelucos, los carmelitas se vieron obligados a abandonar Tierra Santa durante unos dos siglos y medio.
