Pastor's Message

Some reflections as we continue the Synod parish process.

When we say: "our Church," who are the members with whom we share Faith?

How is Jesus asking us to journey together?

Who are the road companions, including those outside the parish community?

What persons or groups do we not consider part of our worshipping community?

Who are left out on the margins?

What offerings could help us journey together better?

How do we promote collaboration with neighboring parishes, with and among religious communities in the area, with and among lay associations and ecclesial movements, etc.?

How do we identify the goals to be pursued, the way to achieve them, and the steps to be taken?

How is authority exercised within our parish Church?

What are the practices of teamwork and co-responsibility?

These are some of the questions that we are called to discern in the synod process. As we are in a unique place in the deanery and in the history of both parishes I think it is important for us to use the Synod process to discern how the Holy Spirit is calling us to listen and help each other change and grow into a parish as family. Both Parishes have one goal, To give witness to the glory of God and to help people get to heaven by the sacraments, the Word, and by our active witness. I think if we focus on that goal and then pray over these questions it will help us all in the coming years as family.

What areas of church life do you think we need to focus on in the coming years here at Incarnation and St Gerard?

How do we do this together as one family, not in competition for God the Fathers love rather in celebration of his eternal love as true children of God?

Every parish exists not to become a cult, looking only into itself for witness and answers, a parish knows that it is a place of the Fathers love, and is secure as a child of God so it looks outward to others to share that love. How can we do that going forward?

Pope Saint John Paul II once said that the church needs to breath with both its spiritual lungs, The East and the West (meaning the Easter Rite and Orthodox churches and the Roman Latin Catholic Church. That could be a good model for us as a changing and growing parish, both parish people need each other to fully do its mission, how can we breath together over the next 10 years in the life of the parish?

Just some thoughts as we journey together in faith.

Mensaje de Parroco

Algunas reflexiones mientras continuamos el proceso parroquial del Sínodo. Cuando decimos "nuestra Iglesia:"

- ¿Quiénes son los miembros con los que compartimos la fe?
- ¿Cómo nos pide Jesús que caminemos juntos?
- ¿Quiénes son los compañeros de camino, incluidos los que están fuera de la comunidad parroquial?
- ¿Qué personas o grupos no consideramos parte de nuestra comunidad de culto?
- ¿Quiénes quedan al margen?
- ¿Qué otras cosas podrían ayudarnos mejor para caminar juntos?
- ¿Cómo promovemos la colaboración con las parroquias vecinas, con y entre las comunidades religiosas de la zona, con y entre las asociaciones de laicos y los movimientos eclesiales, etc.?
- ¿Cómo identificamos los objetivos a perseguir, el modo de alcanzarlos y los pasos a dar?
- ¿Cómo se ejerce la autoridad dentro de nuestra Iglesia parroquial?
- ¿Cuáles son las prácticas de trabajo en equipo y de corresponsabilidad?

Estas son algunas de las preguntas que estamos llamados a discernir en el proceso sinodal. Como estamos en un lugar único en el decanato y en la historia de ambas parroquias, creo que es importante que utilicemos el proceso sinodal para discernir cómo el Espíritu Santo nos está llamando a escuchar y ayudarnos mutuamente a cambiar y a crecer en una parroquia como familia. Ambas parroquias tienen un objetivo: dar testimonio de la gloria de Dios y ayudar a la gente a llegar al cielo mediante los sacramentos, la Palabra y nuestro testimonio activo. Creo que si nos centramos en ese objetivo y luego oramos sobre estas preguntas nos ayudará a todos en los próximos años como familia.

¿En qué áreas de la vida de la iglesia crees que debemos centrarnos en los próximos años aquí en la Encarnación y en San Gerardo? ¿Cómo lo hacemos juntos como una familia, no en competencia por el amor de Dios Padre sino en celebración de su amor eterno como verdaderos hijos de Dios?

Cada parroquia existe para no convertirse en un culto, buscando sólo en sí misma el testimonio y las respuestas, una parroquia sabe que es un lugar de amor del Padre, y está segura que es un hijo de Dios, por lo que mira hacia fuera para compartir ese amor con otros. ¿Cómo podemos hacerlo en el futuro?

El Papa Juan Pablo II dijo una vez que la Iglesia necesita respirar con sus dos pulmones espirituales, el de Oriente y el de Occidente (es decir, las iglesias de rito oriental, las ortodoxas y la Iglesia Romana Católica Latina). Ese podría ser un buen modelo para nosotros como parroquia cambiante y en crecimiento, ambas parroquias se necesitan mutuamente para realizar plenamente su misión, ¿cómo podemos respirar juntos en los próximos 10 años en la vida de la parroquia? Sólo algunos pensamientos mientras caminamos juntos en la fe.

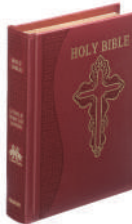
